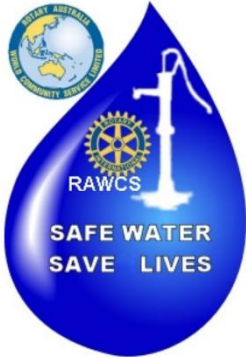

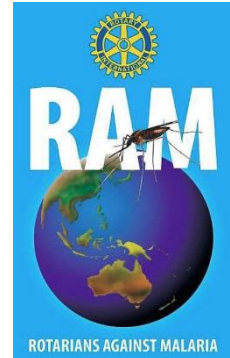
In Russell's absence due to a painful back, our guest and past DG, **Doug Layng**, chaired the meeting.

After the lovely historic Victoria, visited by James Cook in 1778, they were particularly impressed by the glacial area near Banff, Niagara Falls, Montreal (Leonard Cohen's hometown) and *the walled* Quebec City.

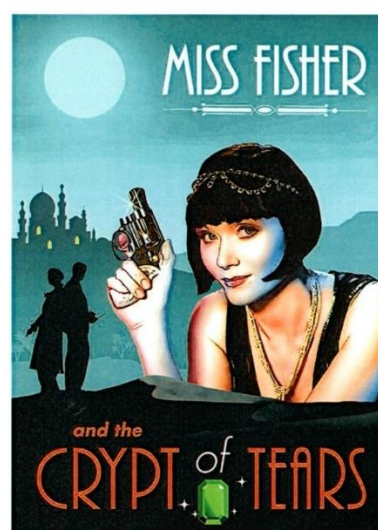
