

### Basic Computing Discussion

**Jack Pappin** led this week’s discussion on basic computing. It covered the use of **emails** and the avoidance of *Reply All* and to only use *bcc* for large lists. Various types of Spam or Junk mail were also presented. Some tricks in the use of **Word** were covered including Save As and the use of *Track Changes* and *Language* in the **Review** tab. It also covered the insertion of photos, together with the use of *Wrap Text*, *Crop* and *Compress* from the **Picture Format** tab.

The use of the **Snip tool** by simultaneously pressing  + **Shift + S** was also demonstrated.
