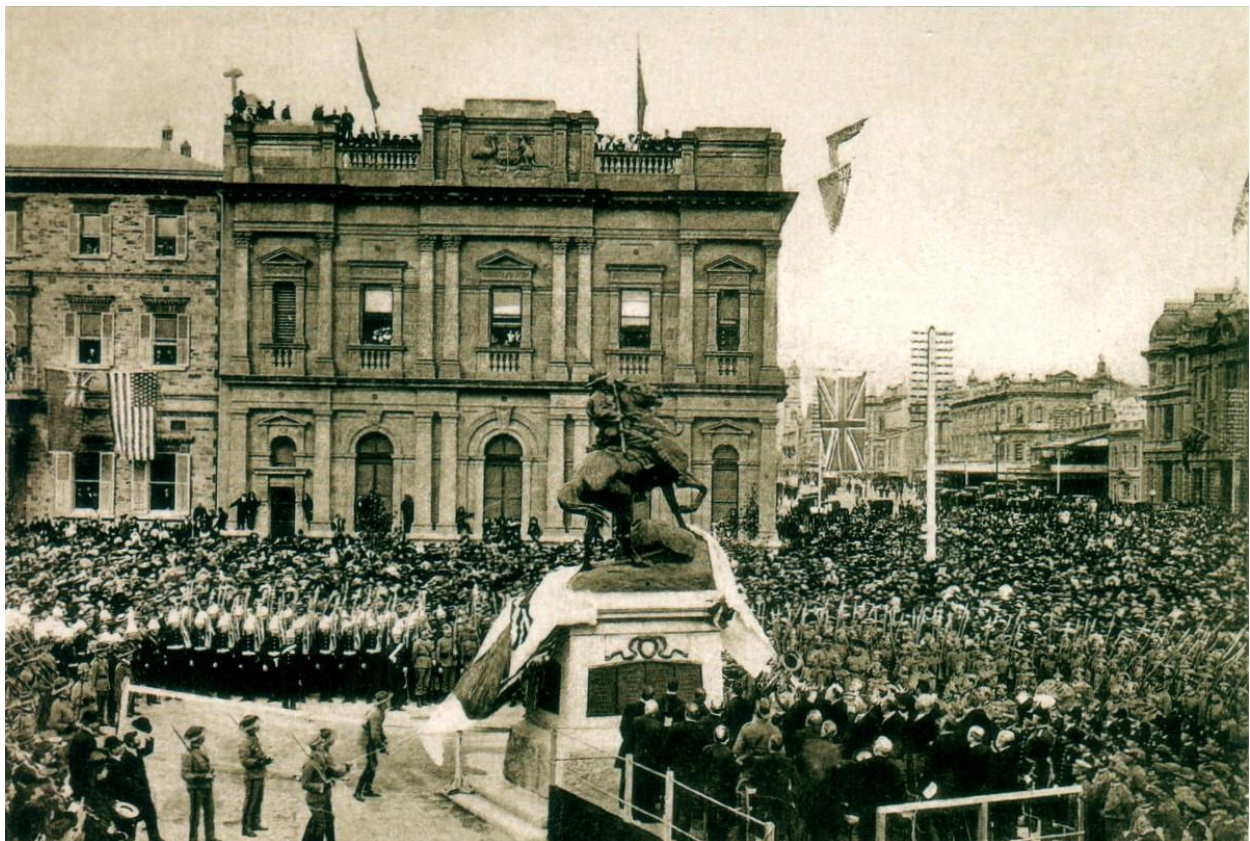
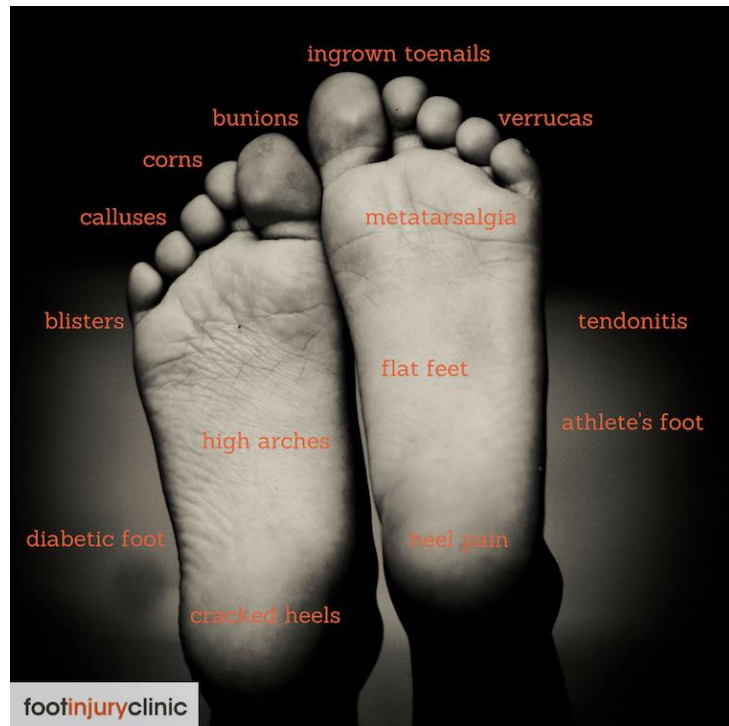
### Guest speaker – Angela Ellis on Nursing and Drew's Uncle George

This week we were entertained by Angela who gave us a brief overview of her career in nursing and, in particular, as a **pediatrist**.

She showed us this educational view of what can go wrong with people's feet and other photos of some extreme conditions.

She then went on to describe Drew's Uncle George who fought in the Boer War (1899-1902) and who was the model for the statue erected at the NE corner of North Terrace and King William Road in 1904 (see below). As

this was the first war involving Australian Soldiers overseas, it was Adelaide's first war memorial and clearly was a major event in its day.
