## Notes from Meeting 2025 – DG Visit – 10<sup>th</sup> of November

Jack Kelso introduced guest **Jill Rivers**. Jill has worked with Anglicare for many years and became known to the club through her role at the **St. Bede's Drop in Centre** at Semaphore. This programme caters for people who, for a variety of reasons, are disconnected from mainstream society and it also provides a safe place for social interaction and nutrition. Our club has provided financial and material support for it over a number of years including the purchase of a table tennis table, billiard table and refrigerator. Jill has previously spoken at the club and it was with the greatest pleasure that the Board agreed to award **Jill a Paul Harris Fellowship**. Her surprise and gratitude was special to observe.



Angela Ellis presented a letter from **Federal Senator Andrew McLachlan**, congratulating our club on its 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

**DG David** then addressed the meeting with a comprehensive and informative presentation of his own journey in Rotary as well as the messages of encouragement from RI President Holger Knaack. David's own journey had begun as a Rotaractor in 1978. He encouraged early registration for the District 9510 Conference planned for April 2021. He also highlighted the fact that 2021 was the 'Centenary' year of Rotary in Australia & NZ and encouraged the club to consider a 'Centenary Project'. 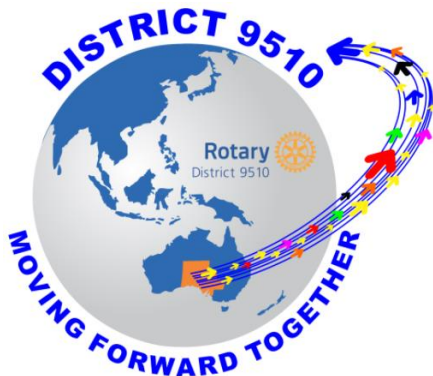
