He was a property investor who loved to repair and maintain his children's (Scott & Priscilla) houses. He had a mechanical and engineering bent and was involved in the establishment of the annual (except for 2020) **Darwin to Adelaide Solar Car Challenge**. At different times, Trevor exhibited his sculptural works along the clifftop walk between Bronte and Bondi in New South Wales and along the beachfront in some of Adelaide's southern suburbs.

Trevor was **inducted** into the Rotary Club of Regency Park on 23 October 2007 and remained a member until failing health prevented his regular attendance. In 2019, he was awarded a Paul Harris Fellowship by our Club in recognition of his service to Rotary and the community.
