Les raised the possible **Bunnings Sausage Sizzle** on the 21st of March and it was agreed we would support it.

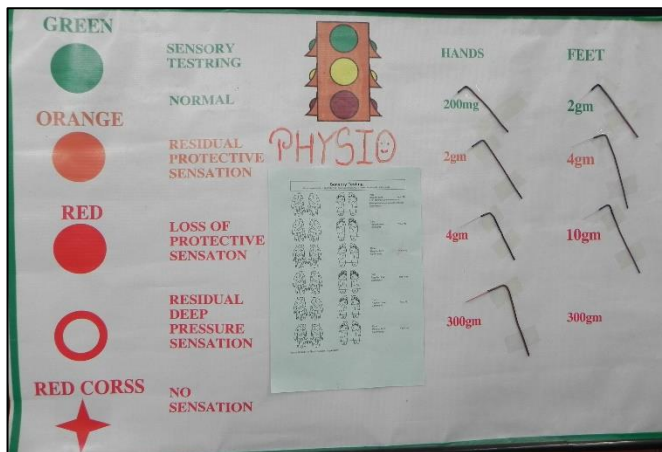
Jack K suggested that we attend some future girls football games at Port District Football Club and provide diabetic blood testing to any onlookers who wished to participate.

Guest Speaker – Brian Wheatley – Leprosy in Nepal

Brian delivered a highly informative talk outlining the nature of this disease, which is an immune reaction in a similar way to TB. It is bacterial and spread by nasal droplets and requires prolonged exposure to be transmitted from one person to another. 95% of humans are immune even under these circumstances. The disease can be cured but not the damage that has already occurred which is usually to the skin appearance and failure of limbs in the extreme. Brian described how the Green Pastures Hospital (GPH) in Pokhara is now leading the effort against leprosy in the western half of Nepal, and how it is supported by the Nepalese Government in this effort. Their long-term skills in this area including their ability in making prosthetic limbs is particularly useful. They need financial support and Brian is investigating the possibility of a District Grant amongst other things.
