### Guest Speakers - Lenard Sciancalepore & Liam Hayes

Lenard and Liam met at the 2017 RYLA Conference and spoke about their work raising money for philanthropic causes. **Lenard** described his leadership of the **Adelaide University Rotaract Club** where he founded the now flagship fundraising event, **Cultural Night**. The club now has 55 members, which includes 20 ethnicities and with 58% being female. The club particularly focusses on multicultural activities and is also collecting bread tags which eventually end up as wheelchairs in South Africa.

Lenard stressed that they are keen available to help us if we need extra hands for any fundraising activity and that they are looking to us for mentoring.

Following his RYLA experience, **Liam** co-founded **The Good Bunch**, a wine business that aims to raise \$1,000,000 for charity by helping Australians drink better quality wine at great prices. 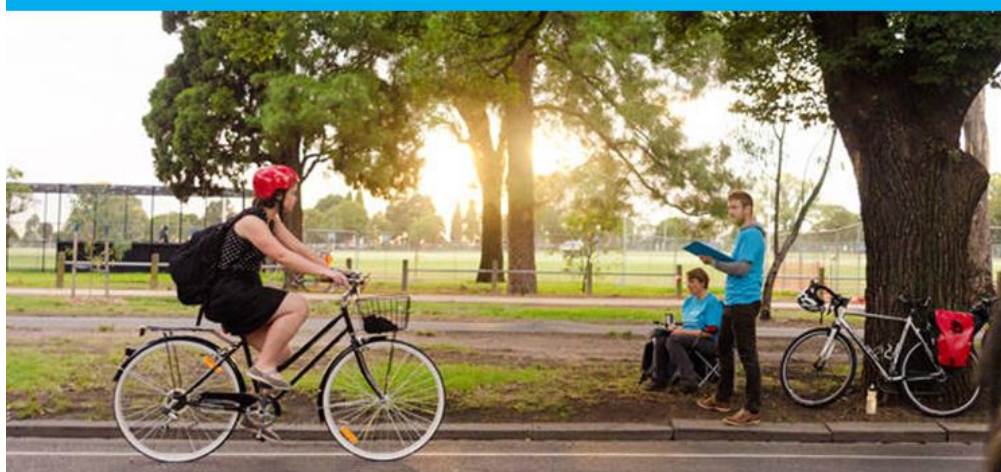
