Notes from Meeting 2043 – 6th of April

This week we had apologies from **Ernie** and **Jack K. Ron**, **Ashleigh** and **Jack P** were also absent as they were on the Corolla Capers 2021 reconnaissance trip to Silverton. We were very pleased to have Area 12 Governor, **Jeff Cluse**, and President of the RC of Prospect, **Barrie Trevarrow**, as guests.

Les reported that we had a very successful day at **Bunnings** on Easter Saturday with a profit nudging \$1000. The next Sausage Sizzles requiring a team are Sunday the 25th of April (with a later morning start time as it is ANZAC Day) and Saturday the 22nd of May.

Jeff and **Barrie** reported the successful conclusion to the Joint District Grant project as already reported in the Bulletin. Mark Streich accompanied them on the tour of HYPA when delivering the packs. HYPA stands for '**Helping Young People Achieve**' and comes under the umbrella of the Services to Youth Council. The success of this joint project raised the potential for future such projects and HYPA was seen as a worthy area to consider for ongoing support.

Russell reported that he had been a guest speaker at Prospect RC regarding the Murray River kayaking journey that he and Peter Sowden from Walkerville had undertaken to raise funds for the **Rotary Action Group Against Slavery** in Kalimpong, West Bengal. The RC of Prospect had decided to donate \$500 to that project and this photo shows Russell being presented with the cheque by **Jeff** and **Barrie**.



Guest Speaker, Mark Streich

Mark, our newest member, gave an overview of his working life as a well over 30 years as a **Registered Nurse** which began at the Strathmont Centre, Oakden, caring for people with a range of disabilities. Most of his time however was as a **Psychiatric Nurse** at Hillcrest and, in particular, **Forensic Custodial Care** at James Nash House. He demonstrated a passion for his role and gave us a glimpse of some of the colourful aspects of his career in what was one of the highest security facilities in the country. The most significant impression was his strong desire to encourage other health professionals that he worked with to see the 'inmates' as other than a 'labelled diagnosis' but as people who had families, social environments and other factors which impacted on how they had come to be as they were.



Mark did a Post Graduate Doctorate in this area for which he received an award. He also identified some of the changes in management that had evolved over time with the advent of better pharmacological agents as well as the move to de-institutionalised care.

It was an understated presentation of what clearly has been a highly valuable career. Vic presented Mark with a club glass as a token of thanks as shown here.
