We also had our guest presenters, **Lee** and **PDG Sam Camporeale** gave an interesting and informative overview of the benefits of the **Rotary Foundation** and how the PHFs operate within it. A highlight of the night was the presentation of a **PHF** to **Ted Pawelski** who has been assisting Jack Kelso deliver excess bread from Bakers Delight to deserving causes for many years. Brian reports that, since 1995, our club has recognised 33 Members, 7 Non-Members, a Corporate Certificate of Appreciation, and funded 12 additional Sapphire stones to their PHF's. In addition, there have been PHF recognition and sapphire additions to current members, either from other clubs, District Leadership or through their own accumulated donations to the Centurion fund. The accumulated benefit to the Rotary Foundation is US\$60,000.

Delivery of Sound System to Largs Bay School

Principal Mike Tate, on behalf of the Largs Bay School community, took delivery of our 4th Soundfield System that we have donated to them. These sound systems provide an amplification of the teacher's voice to allow instructions to be delivered in a clear, controlled voice, while our students, both with and without hearing issues, can receive information with little distraction.
