Russell, Les and **John O** attended the **District Assembly** which was especially important for us regarding applying for District Grants.

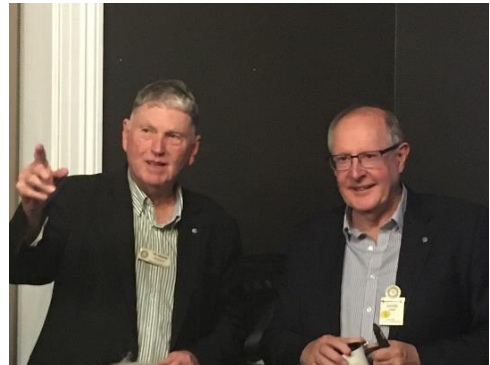


Guest speaker - PDG David Egan

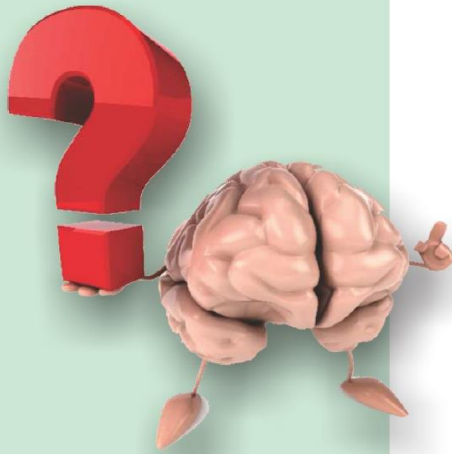
