

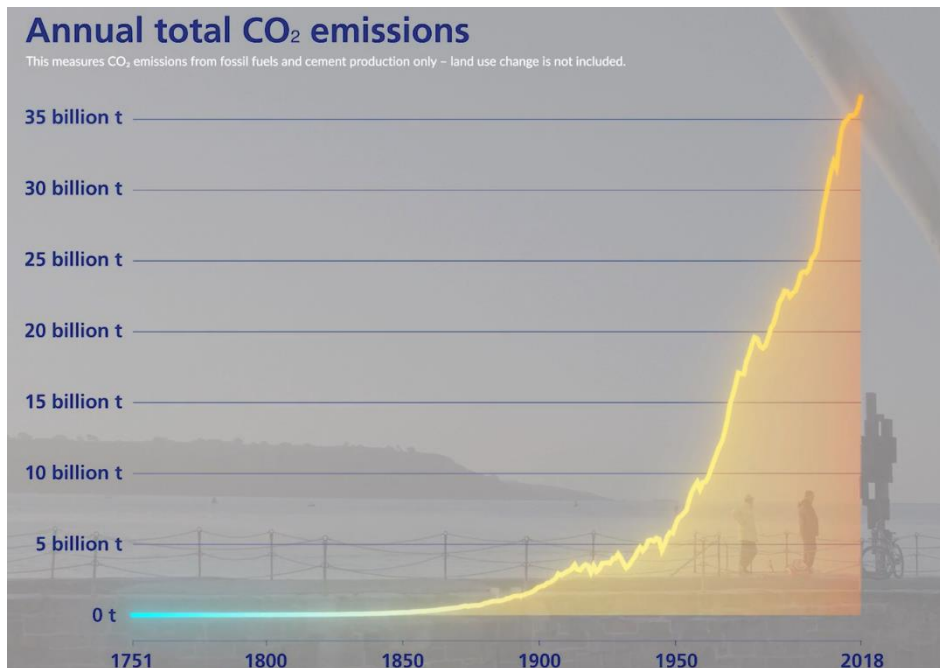
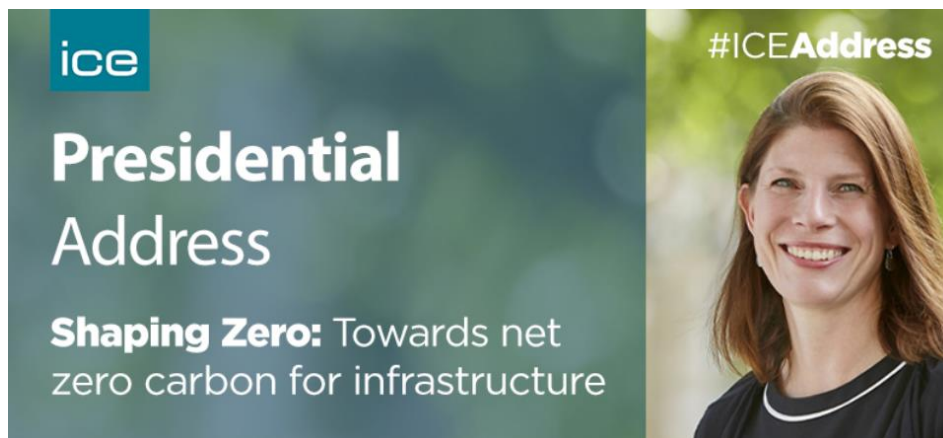
Dale gave another excellent and brief excerpt of the history of the club and also confirmed that the first **Corolla Capers** was in 2003 making this year's event the 19th.

Film – Shaping zero

Our feature was a 25 minute film made by the ICE President, Rachel Skinner, in November 2020. ICE stands for the Institution of Civil Engineers, which is the professional body for Civil Engineers in the United Kingdom. Climate Change is an issue that the UK Government has been tackling for over 15 years but the message in this film is that the efforts must be accelerated if the 1.5°C target is to be achieved. Civil Engineers, through their efforts as creating our current infrastructure over the past 200 years, have unwittingly been a major cause of the problem and this film explains how now they must be a major driver to bring the problem back under control.
