**Phishing Scams** generally start with an email or phone call. They may look real, but **DO NOT click** on any information **links**. Any real email or call will not ask for information. If in doubt use your own contact data if you decide to contact the business or company.

If in need, use the **ScamWatch.com.au** web site.

Beware of any SMS from the **Tax Department** if it includes a link - just delete it.

**Money Scams** - if it sounds too good to be true ... **it is. Delete.**

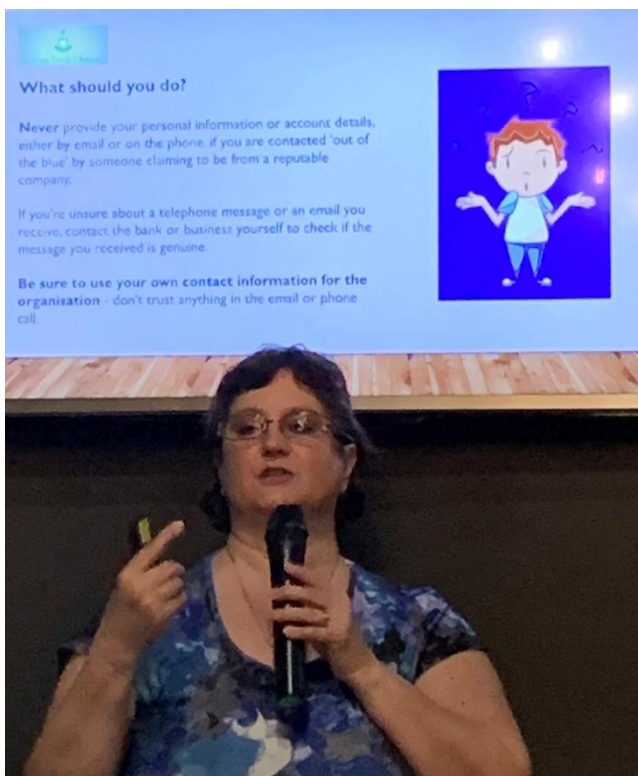
**Delete Inheritance Scams** (Rich person has died leaving you a fortune and bank details are needed) and also **Lottery Scams** (You have won a lottery and bank details are needed).

**Social Media Scams**, generally romance scams preying on the lonely - signs are they express their feelings too soon. Others claim financial hardship.

**Passwords:** **DO NOT** record your passwords and keep them with your device.

**DO NOT** use the obvious.....birth dates, phone numbers, house numbers.

**Use** multiple capitals, e.g., olIveR , F7!Day.

## Social Weekend at Calperum - 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> of November

You will be staying in Rotary House and other similar accommodation on the property which are all comfortable with modern kitchens. Meals will be provided, and cost shared between all attending – all you need to bring is your red cordial or similar.

### PROGRAM

**Friday** – after purchasing the food at the Woolworth shopping centre in Renmark at noon, we will go in convoy to Calperum. Later we will do a walk around the place to show you the lakes, Ral Ral Creek, the Education area etc.

**Saturday morning** – *Calperum Station Floodplain Tour* (\$45/head) - see the unique environmental, historical, and cultural wonders of Calperum Station. Calperum rangers guide the tour, with several interesting and immersive stops along the way. Meet our ecologists and learn of the important research and restoration projects being conducted on the property. The tour visits Lake Merreti and Woolpolool historical and cultural landmarks and will show you the abundant flora and fauna.

**Saturday afternoon** - We may go and check some other sites out or just do some fellowship.

**Saturday evening** – Open fire outside – solving the world's problems.

**Sunday** – Clean up and depart for home.
