Notes from Meeting #2064 – 7th of September

We had **apologies** from John O and Brian and were delighted to welcome a guest, **Molly Tseng**, from Taiwan who is here doing a catering course at the Regency Park TafeSA.

Dale told us more of the early **club history** and Les passed confirmed the roster for the forthcoming **Bunnings Sausage Sizzle** on the 12th of September and Jack K for the **Carousel** on the 25th and 26th of September noting that the hours have changed to 11am to 2 & 2 to 5pm on both days. Russell reported he is finalising the initial order of our **club shirts**.

Jack P advised that Sandi Fulcher (Trachoma coordinator) now wishes to have 1000 towels and 500 pairs of sheets sourced from DIK to be sent to the Anyinginyi Health Aboriginal Corporation in **Tennant Creek**. We agreed to have a working bee at DIK to sort these out on the morning of Saturday the 18th of September at DIK. **Angela** confirmed that we have agreed to prepare 40 more **Trachoma kits** in conjunction with **Adelaide Light** Rotary Club to send a total of 70 kits to Tennant Creek School.

Ken and Vic are to explore various items for these kits

Ron announced that he and Mark had interviewed and recommended Mohamad Aldiab for **RYLA** and Jasmen Ahrens for the **Rotary Youth Sailing Challenge** which is held on the **One and All**.

Both involve a sponsorship of \$950.

Jack K suggested that the October away walk be to **Rose Darling** at Port Adelaide and appealed for more clothes to be donated to them.

Guest speaker – Peter Zander - Kiwanis

Our guest speaker this week, Peter Zander, talked to us about Kiwanis. This is a charitable organisation that has the motto '**make a difference**' and was set up in 1915 and operates along similar lines to Rotary but tends to focus on international projects. In Australia they have similar membership issues to Rotary, but they are being very successful in Asia, particularly Taiwan where they have 17,500 members. They are active in areas of people with intellectual difficulties and on improving the life of children in areas such as Nepal and Sri Lanka. Kiwanis have clubs for 8 to 10 year-olds, 10 to 14 year-olds, 14 to 18 year-olds and for adults. Peter stressed that to attract younger members, any organisation must have interesting and meaningful projects.
