Angela & Brian made a very interesting and convincing talk and demonstration of how to use our **automated external defibrillator (AED)**. It is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses life-threatening heart rhythms and is able to treat them through defibrillation, the application of electricity to encourage the heart to re-establish an effective rhythm. It is normally only used on someone who is **unconscious**. If all's well, it will work the first time.
