Guest Speaker – Lukas Gerstweiler – Vaccine research

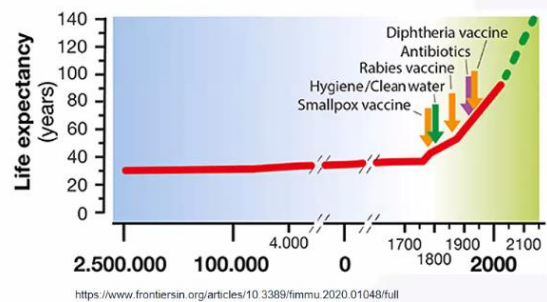
Lukas (pictured above on RHS) is a lecturer at the School of Chemical Engineering and Advanced Materials at The University of Adelaide, teaching biomanufacturing and food & brewing technologies. Before moving to Adelaide, he studied chemical engineering focussing on bio-process technologies.

His research focuses on advanced and intensified production technologies for future vaccines.

He also enjoys wakeboarding on the Murray River and exploring the sea life of South Australia.

Lukas gave a very interesting presentation on the past, present and probable future of vaccine development. This is his introductory image and shows the dramatic effect that vaccination and other hygiene and medical advances has had on life expectancy, increasing from about 40 years in 1800 to about 90 years at present and forecast to be over 140 years by 2150.

- Vaccine is a biological preparation that provides active acquired immunity
- Best method preventing infectious diseases
- Prophylactic (prevent) or therapeutic (fight)
- Some prevent infection completely
- Term *vaccine* derives from *Variolae vaccinae* (cow smallpox)
- Very high safety standards (FDA)
