## Guest Speakers Liz Horrocks & Peter Sowden

**Liz** made a very interesting presentation about Walkerville Rotary Club’s programme **‘Celebration of Learning’**. The programme started in 2014 at the Walkerville Primary School and comprises giving children \$25 book vouchers. The students are selected by their teacher and the criteria is based on effort and progress rather than achievement. This enables a wider group of children to be eligible for an award and often promotes a sense of achievement to those who normally wouldn’t receive such an award. The scheme has proved to be very popular and is well received by both teachers and students. It is now operating at 7 schools in the Walkerville area and last year 104 awards were made.

**Peter** followed up with another programme by the Walkerville Rotary Club called **‘Pleasant Sunday Afternoons’**. This entails hosting an event at about 3-month intervals at the Walkerville Town Hall. The club serves afternoon tea and cakes at same stage through the event. The events range from musical performances by school students to showing a movie. The next event, on Sunday the **6<sup>th</sup> of March** at 2pm, is the movie **‘Fisherman’s Friends’**. Other events this year are on the **19<sup>th</sup> of June**, the **18<sup>th</sup> of September** & the **11<sup>th</sup> of December**. A gold coin donation is sought from attendees. Peter is finding it hard to publicise these events and is looking for ways to do this. His target is about 40 people, but he rarely gets as many as that.

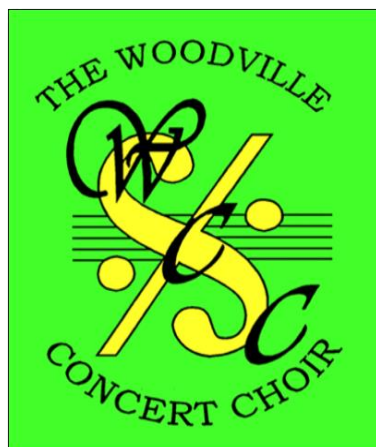
