Guest Speaker, **Connie Bonaros – Share the Dignity**

Angela introduced Connie to us advising that they had grown up together for several years in a small settlement about 15km from Coober Pedy and have been good friends ever since.

Connie gave a very interesting presentation on **Period Poverty** and the good work done by **Share the Dignity** (see below which is extracted from their website). She has been a member of the SA Legislative Council since 2018 and described various efforts and bills she has been involved in with Period Poverty. She discussed how Scotland have a universal supply of period products and how this leads to a better education experience for young girls. Victoria is also embarking on a similar programme with a projected cost of \$26m. She also discussed the difficulties that can occur within some immigrant communities within Australia. She concluded with a brief discussion on the recent SA Government Election results.

SHARE THE *Dignity*



Share the Dignity’s work directly benefits those in crisis experiencing period poverty and they believe that everyone deserves to be afforded the dignity so many of us take for granted. It is a women's charity in Australia, that works to make a real difference in the lives of those experiencing homelessness, fleeing domestic violence, or doing it tough. They distribute period products to women, girls, and anyone who menstruates, who needs support. When someone is doing it tough, the last thing on their mind should be dealing with their period.
