Guest Speaker – Steve Knight – House Building



Steve has the Executive Director of the **Housing Industry Association** for the past 5 years. He gave an interesting presentation on his personal history from becoming a draftsman, progressing to setting up his own building company before moving to HIA. He explained that the HIA is not for profit and has 40,000 members in Australia. It aims to be an association that speaks with a united voice on industry issues and creating real change, provides quality services at the lowest possible cost and works with the sector to maintain high standards through self-regulated commercial conduct. In SA the housing industry comprises 6.8% of the GDP and employs over 50,000 people and builds about 14,000 units a year. Steve acknowledged that the industry is currently under pressure due to rising costs. He is pictured here being thanked by President Angela.

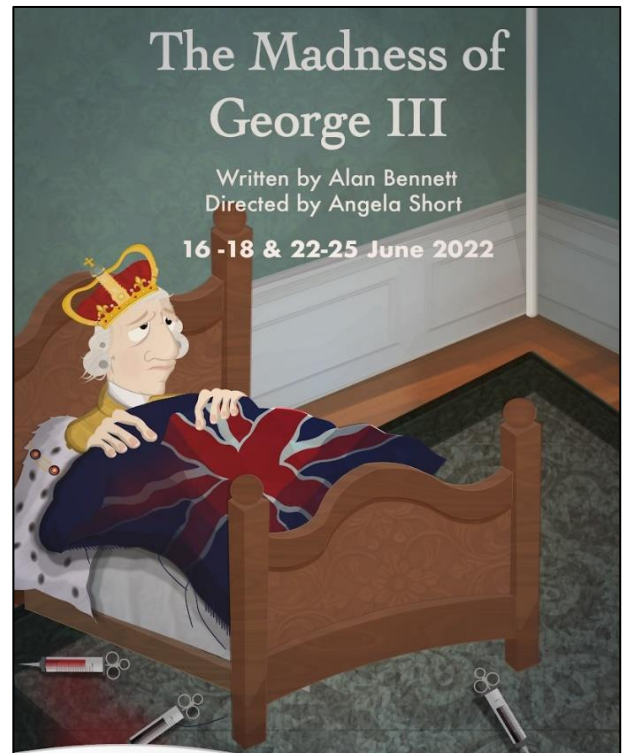
