## Notes from Meeting #2107 – 2<sup>nd</sup> of August

This week we had apologies from **Dale, Vic, Jack P, John O, Ernie & Jack K** and were very pleased to be joined by **Barrie Trevarrow** from the Rotary Club of Prospect.

Our anticipated speaker, **Shiralee Judge**, Area Governor of Area 10 and member of the Rotary Club of Mt. Barker, who was to discuss **Domestic Violence Support**, was unable to attend and a meeting has now been arranged by Jeff Cluse to occur at **5pm this Tuesday the 9<sup>th</sup> of August**, at the **Caledonian Hotel**.

**Treasurer Russell** reported a successful day at **Bunnings** on Saturday the 30<sup>th</sup> of July with a profit of about \$950. It was noted that very few commented on the increase from \$2.50 to \$3.50 for a 'Sizzle' but we don't, of course, know how many might have chosen not to partake.

The steady rate of demand would suggest, not many.

**Russell** also reported that nearly all the financials for **Corolla Capers 2022** were complete and that a healthy amount of money had been raised. The committee would decide how much to distribute to each of the nominated beneficiaries.

**Les** reported that our next **Bunnings** booking is for Sunday the 28<sup>th</sup> of August, which again is a Carousel weekend. He noted that this day will be a day when we are able to **Market our club** and there will be an opportunity to display our club using our Marquee along with other display material.

Les is still finding out details of what Bunnings was planning regarding them paying for some product and giving away 'free sizzles' at some stage.

**John Goodridge** announced that he had become a grandfather again with the addition of 'Lucas John'.

**John** also informed us that the next **Vocational Visit**, on **Tuesday the 30<sup>th</sup> of August**, will be to his son, Lewis', business, '**BAR 38**' at **308 Greenhill Road, Glenside**. Lewis will give an overview of what was involved in establishing the business and then we can enjoy a \$40 a head, 'all you can eat' meal which includes specialty pizzas. Drinks will be extra.

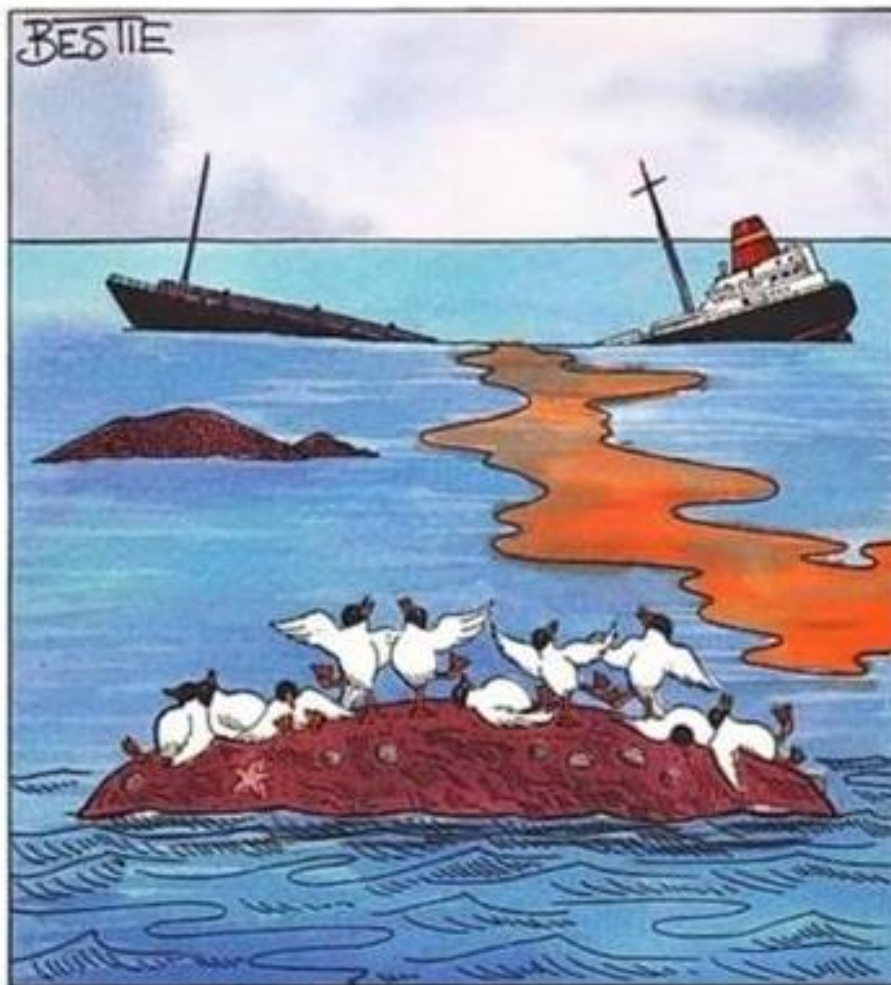
