Further to our telephone call, Edwin Currall, the principal of the Canteen Creek School, sent this report from their most recent Trachoma Team visit:

In June 2022, the children were screened (had their eyelids lifted up) to check for signs of trachoma. Of the target population of 5-9yr olds none had trachoma. The Team commends Canteen Creek on their hard work to keep Trachoma away, as this is the 1<sup>st</sup> year without endemic trachoma prevalence in our target population. Please keep up the great effort as trachoma is still in parts of the NT.
