Notes from Meeting #2112 – 6th of September

This week we had apologies from **John O, Paul & Jack K** and were very pleased to be joined by several friends and family members. Special guests included DG Paul Thomas, PDG Doug Layng and President of the Adelaide Light Rotary Club, John Wotherspoon.

The meeting was special being the first **M** night that are designed to have a special guest and be a good opportunity for members to invite people who may be interested in becoming members in the longer term.



DG, Paul Thomas, was invited to give opening comments to the meeting and he explained how Rotary has become an integral part of his life since he was a Rotary Exchange Student to Japan as a young man. Since then, he has travelled to Japan on several occasions and has hosted Rotary Exchange students from Japan. Now, as DG, he is committed to advancing Rotary at every opportunity.

Guest Speaker - Erfan Abidi – the Collapse of Afghanistan

Erfan gave a very interesting, harrowing and quite emotional talk about his experience of fleeing with his family, from Kabul after it fell to the Taliban on the 15th of August 2021. He explained how he had been born in Kabul in 1992 and had enjoyed a relatively idyllic childhood and teenage life. He became an interpreter in 2009 and had become married and now has 3 sons. At the age of 22 he was recruited by the government as the Convoy Operations Manager. Although he had applied for a US, UK and Australian visas, none had materialised by the fateful day in August when the Taliban took control. He was a marked man and being hunted by the time his Australian Visa arrived on the 23rd of August. Erfan described how he and his family managed to get to the chaotic airport and make contact with Australian soldiers. Fortunately, they made a safe landing in Adelaide where they still reside. Currently he is working hard to help extricate others who are still in Kabul.
