We also agreed to a request from **St Bede's** via **Jack K** for \$935 towards a defibrillator that will be available for use by the public in Port Adelaide.

### Guest Speaker – Steve Sutton – "Village as Verb"

Steve has recently completed a PhD on disaster resilience and made a compelling argument as to the effectiveness of local historical knowledge in educating and preparing people for future disasters. He used the example of residents on the Indonesian Simeulue Cut Island to the southwest of Sumatra, who survived by knowing from their ancestors to head to the hills when they felt the ground shake in the 2004 Boxing Day Earthquake which caused massive tsunami damage. Steve stressed the importance of *local community knowledge* in any disaster where people are very dependent on their neighbours in the immediate aftermath. It is best if everyone is living in such a *village environment*.

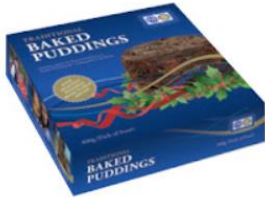
