

Notes from Meeting #2139 – 4th of April

This week we had apologies from **Mark S, Jack K, Ernie** and **John O**.

Angela opened the meeting advising that Derek & Jima Burcham of the **Rotary Club of Playford** were seeking funds to finance a **40' container** full of equipment to be sent from DIK to a **hospital** in the **Philippines**. They have raised \$3600 towards the shipping cost which has recently increased considerably to almost \$6000 and are looking to other clubs for support.

Les advised that we have two probable catering events coming up in early May (see Page 3) that would require our BBQ trailer and he is following them up. The first in aid of **Domestic Violence** organised by Embolden and the second is for a **Doggy Day on the Green** (see below) organised by the PAE and City of Charles Sturt Councils.

Mark S reported through the chair, that Coles Welland are still collecting non-perishable food for us but would like to donate the proceeds to a range of established charities.

Mark C has advised that Dale needs a working bee at his place to clean out an old swimming pool and it was agreed that this would be done after the walk on Friday the 14th of April. **Ron** and **Jeff** agreed to arrange a skip that needs to be 3 to 4m², for that day.

Brian advised that he had been contacted by ROMAC to organise a quiz night for them in late August. It would follow a similar format to the one our club ran at the District Conference in 2022.

Vic advised that he was liaising with Coopers to arrange a brewery tour for us.

Membership follow up

The main part of the meeting was devoted to following up on the membership meeting we attended with other clubs at the Lord Melbourne Hotel on the 7th of February (see Bulletin 20230212 #2132). **Angela** summarised a Health of our Club survey which shows we all comfortable with the current state of our club and its meetings. **Ron** then chaired the remainder of the meeting and advised that the key questions we had previously identified (on the 14th of February) were, in order of priority:

1. *How to engage with our community?*
2. *Knowing what skills our community can offer?*
3. *Who are we targeting, when promoting Rotary?*
4. *How do we engage new members?*

A general discussion then followed with us all prioritising membership actions and achievements using post-it notes and these will be summarised later. Further editions of **What's On** were raised and it was felt that only an electronic version should be prepared and circulated by way of our website and email list members can use other online tools if they wish to. Other social events and interclub visits were also discussed. **Jeff** advised that there be another multi-club membership meeting at the Lord Melbourne Hotel on Tuesday the 16th of May.

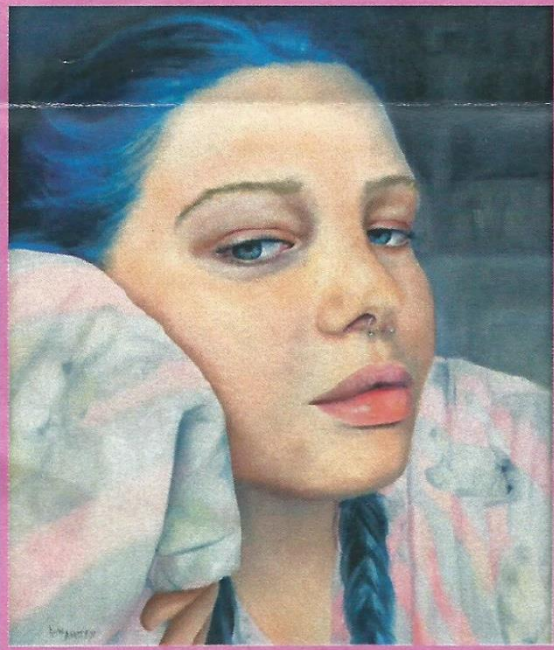
