This week we had apologies from Ernie, Jack K, John O & Steve.

Mark C raised the following request that he has received from a friend.

-- Do you have any old clothes lying around? --

I'm currently living and working in the remote indigenous community of Kaltukatjara, NT. There are no op shops here, the community store costs an arm and a leg, and the closest town (Alice) is 8 hours away. Fuel is over \$3 a litre and the bush bus costs \$200/pp one way into town. Some younger people end up getting ripped off by spending their money on cheap online clothing which tends to fall apart after a few wears.

I'd love to support the community by donating some second-hand clothing. Clothing for babies, children, teens and adults of all sizes are all welcome. Casual loose clothes that cover shoulders and knees are preferred. Loose larger women's sizes would be great. Coming into winter here, and socks, big warm jumpers, comfy long skirts, beanies and such would be great.

I'm happy to do minor repairs if you have clothes that need a little TLC before I distribute. I've been scavenging at the tip here a bit, finding old clothes in the rubble, soaking out red dirt, washing, repairing and handing back out, for which people have been grateful for, including myself as I found a sweet CLC hoodie. Clothes are always appreciated!

> If you'd like to participate and post a small bundle of clothing whilst I'm here, it'll arrive on the weekly airmail plane and I can distribute the items. Auspost 5kg parcels are \$17 or Sendle offers 25kg for around \$40.

> As a first step Mark asks that we all collect clothes and get them to the club.
