The meeting was held at the Lord Melbourne Hotel and was a follow up **Membership Meeting** where we joined the **Walkerville** and **Kent Town** Clubs. Jeff introduced the meeting and again welcomed the District Membership Chair, **Dannielle Camporeale**, of the Port Pirie Rotary club.

The meeting started by **Ron**, as our membership director, summarising the activities that the Regency Park club have been carrying out. These include our attention to branding, focus on projects, the production of 'What's On' flyers and our membership plan.

Walkerville President, **Richard Bentley**, followed by describing their ongoing projects, including their annual Art Show, quarterly concerts, their learning initiative with 9 local schools and their Anzac Day BBQ at the local RSL club.

Kent Town President, **Leah Dametto**, followed with the results of a survey they have attempted to get an outsiders view of Rotary. She reported that many people were unclear of Rotaries goals and especially about Rotary finances.

Danielle then setup the main objective of the meeting as follows:

Each club set about to create a **SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic & Time bound**) plan to address membership and related club culture issues.

Our club came up with various plans involving a long-term systematic approach to membership with 4 monthly meetings, defining roles for new members and updating membership packs. More targeted efforts including 'Come & Try' events where potential members are invited to join in specific activities such as Bunnings BBQ's and approaching local industries in the Regency Park area.to promote Rotary as a useful activity for new retirees.

Danielle closed the meeting by reminding everyone that they should embrace change, or at least try it out, and also that the Rotary International website has a lot of useful information, especially the Learning Centre.
