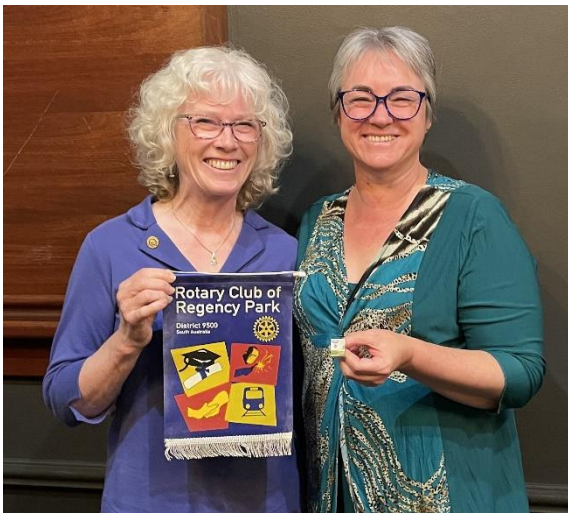

## Notes from Meeting #2145 – 23<sup>rd</sup> of May

This week we were delighted to be joined by international visitors who were on their way to the Rotary International Conference in Melbourne. They were **Penny Millar** from the **Santa Rosa Sunrise Club** in California. The club has about 60 members and their claim to fame is for providing a health care centre in Nicaragua. The others were **Arturo Vargas**, and his wife **Betty**, from the **Tehuacan Club** in Mexico. Their club has about 30 members and there are about 8,000 members overall in Mexico. 42 years ago, Arturo and Betty hosted a girl from Adelaide in a Rotary exchange, and they were here visiting her again before flying to Melbourne. Gifts were exchanged as shown below and it was wonderful to be joined by these visitors who attended of their own volition.



### Guest Speaker - Ralph Greenham – Enfield Probus & Bush Balladeer

Ralph grew up near Griffith NSW and attended Ballarat Teacher's College before becoming a teacher in Primary Schools in Victoria for over 30 years. For family reasons he moved to Adelaide 18 years ago and is now Chairman of the **Enfield Probus Club**. He introduced the Club which provides fellowship and fun for about 30 members all aged over 70 years. Declining membership due to old age and related issues is a serious issue for the club. It has an annual membership fee of \$30.

Ralph then moved onto his real passion which is **Bush Ballads**. He recited the "**The Man from Snowy River**" by **Banjo Patterson** and then proceeded to recite the more contemporary works from **Murray Hartin**, "**Fishing for Cod**" and "**Rain from Nowhere**". The latter is particularly poignant describing the dire condition of drought but reinforcing the importance of hope and faith in seemingly hopeless situations. These renditions were met with great appreciation by the audience.
