2023 Rotary International Convention in Melbourne

President Angela and Brian & Heather joined some 14,000 delegates from around the world in attending the 2023 Rotary International Convention from the 27th to the 31st of May. Brian reports that it was an extraordinary event at which the '**I**' in **RI** was very much on display. General sessions were held each day in the Rod Laver Arena and the opening event, with a flag from each of the 220 countries in which Rotary exists, being brought into the arena (see photo below) and greeted by cheers from their generous number of attendees. We were exposed to many excellent and inspirational speakers, including International President, Jennifer Jones, and entertainment including 'The Tenors' from Canada. A 'House of Friendship' centre and multiple 'break out sessions', covering a wide range of topics, were catered for at the Melbourne Exhibition and Convention Centre. There were optional social events such as a 'Night at the Races' held at Flemington Racecourse. Those involved in organising such an event are exceptional and while clubs such as ours may be 'tiny cogs', we are part of a huge worldwide organisation with an immense potential to build on what has already been achieved. The next Convention in 2024 will be held in Singapore.



District 9510 Expo Dinner at the Wine Centre – Saturday 3rd of June

President Angela, Brian, Jack P, Jeff & Steve and guests attended the dinner which rounded off the District 9510 Expo held earlier in the day at the University of Adelaide. The presentation by the **Honourable Hieu Van Le AC** (shown below) was a highlight of the evening as he outlined his journey by boat from Vietnam in the mid 1970's which ended with him thankfully arriving at Adelaide Airport.

The evening concluded by **Frank O'Neill** introducing the Rotary Club of Adelaide's Centenary **Aboriginal Chronic Disease Prevention Project**, which is being carried out jointly with District 9510, Australian Rotary Health, the University of Adelaide & SAHMRI.
