No guest speaker tonight but a general club conversation with AG Angela explaining the Regionalization for the District.

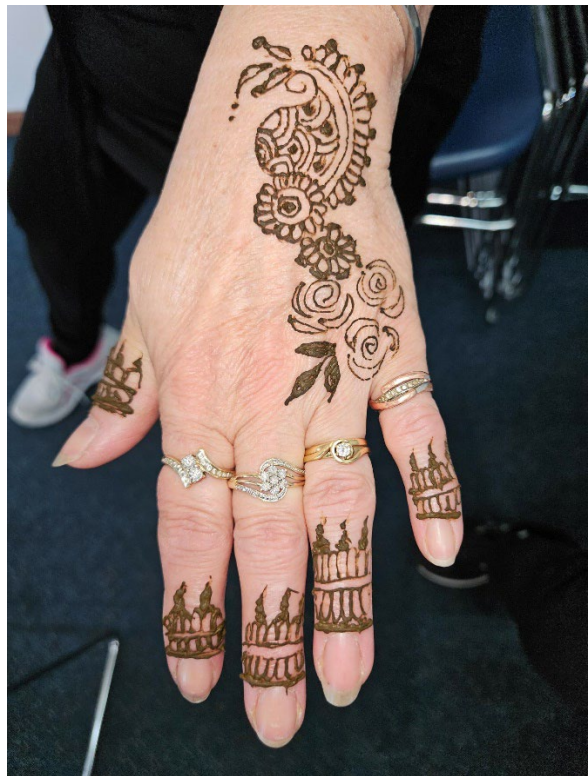
Club Business

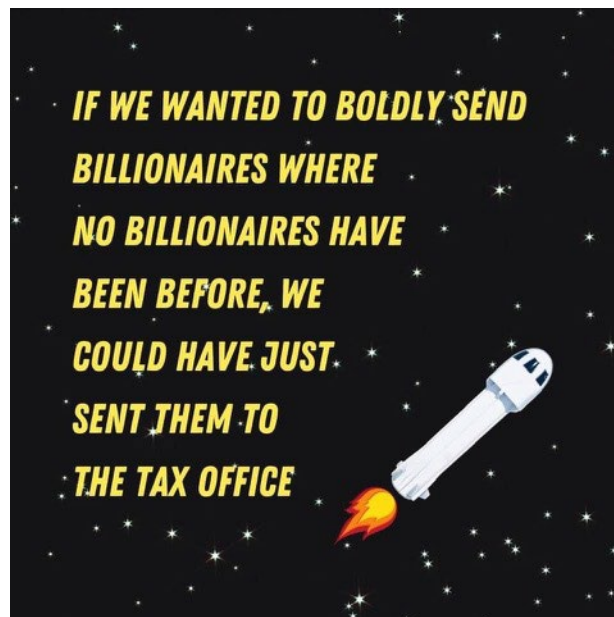
