Richard early this year officially became the CEO of INF Australia.

Green Pastures Hospital in Nepal basically treated leprosy victims but now treats various other illnesses.

INF is now working on supporting self-help groups across the country.

INF has been working on setting up Disaster Recovery groups to respond to land slides after Monsoon rains and earthquakes 40,000 homes were lost in the last earthquake in 2015.

INF also provide education particularly around the stigma on Leprosy and other issues.
