Guest Speaker Spot - Subject – **The Wheatley and Egypt.**



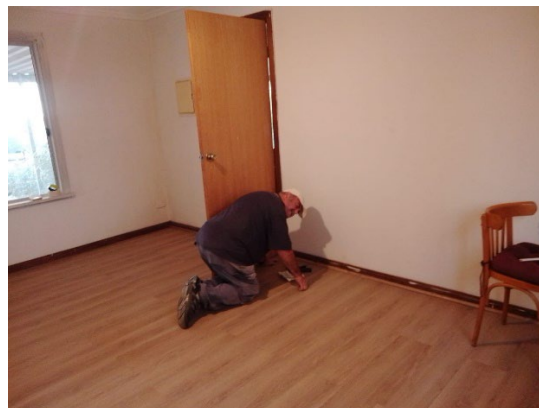
PE Brian and Heather Wheatley recently travelled overseas and visited Egypt.

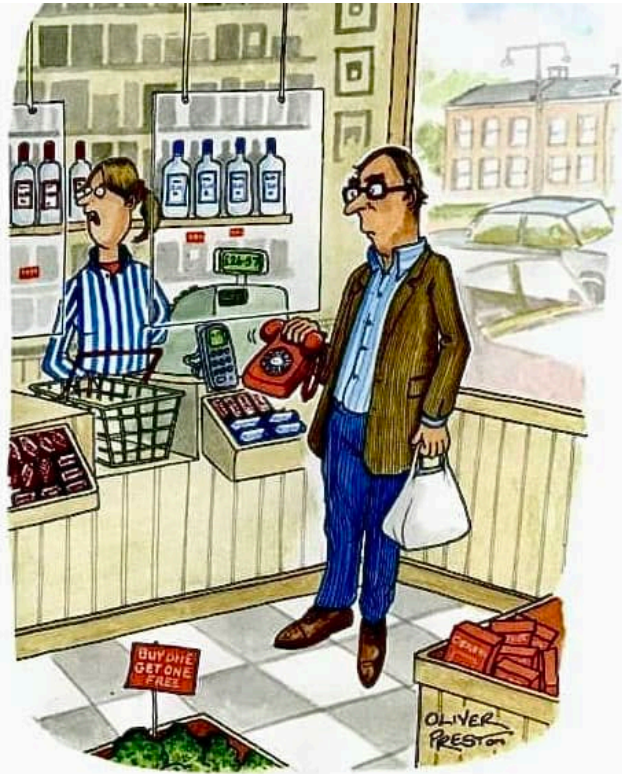
