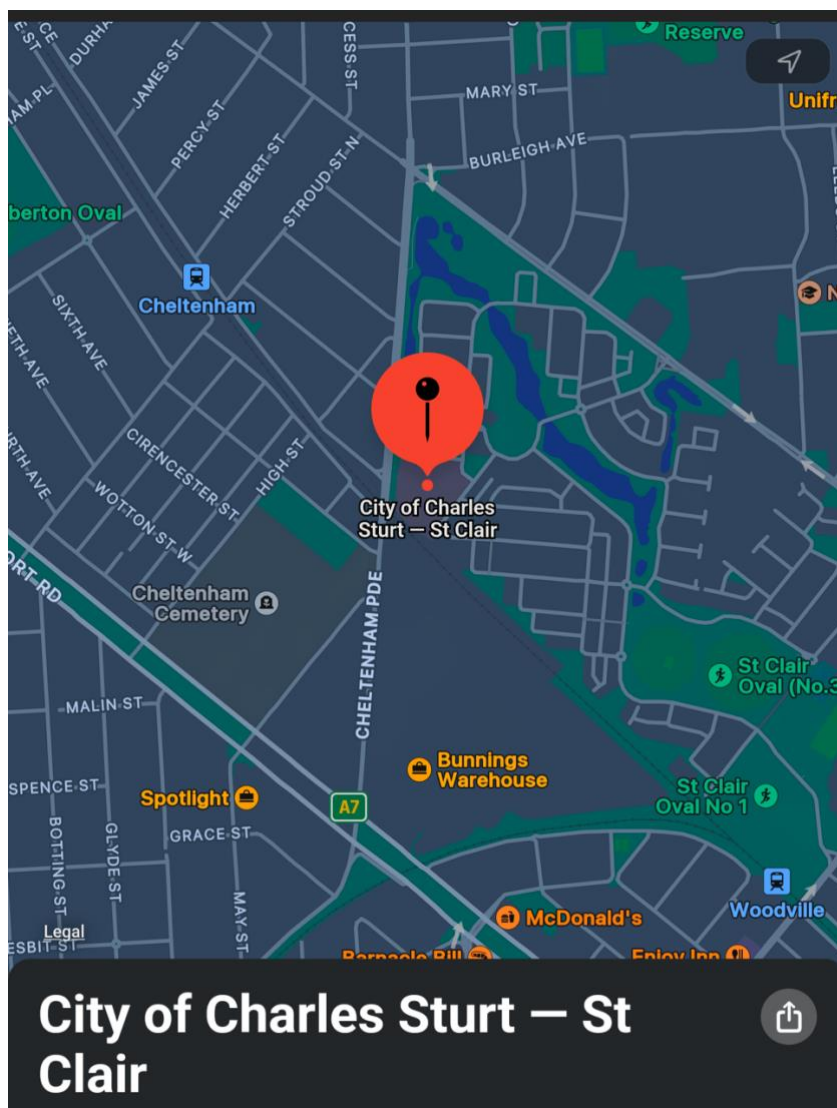
From the cafe we will walk to the **Cheltenham Cemetery** nearby. It is a large cemetery and offers many options if you prefer a shorter walk.
