### International Directors Report April 2025

At the Nowruz Festival event that the club co-sponsored recently, two things particularly impressed

1. The age profile of audience
2. The two prepared messages from our colleague Hadi Jafari, and our DG Marie – Louise.

We had approximately 90 persons in attendance and the average age I would suggest would have been in the high 20's with a significant attendance of students from Thebarton Senior College. We had 12 tables set, 2 family tables including a babe in arms and grandparents. We had a table of invited guests and of course a significant attendance of RCRP members in the kitchen or cooking outside. Over two thirds of those in attendance had strong connection with the Adelaide Afghan Community and certainly the cultural traditions of dance and song were strongly apparent.
